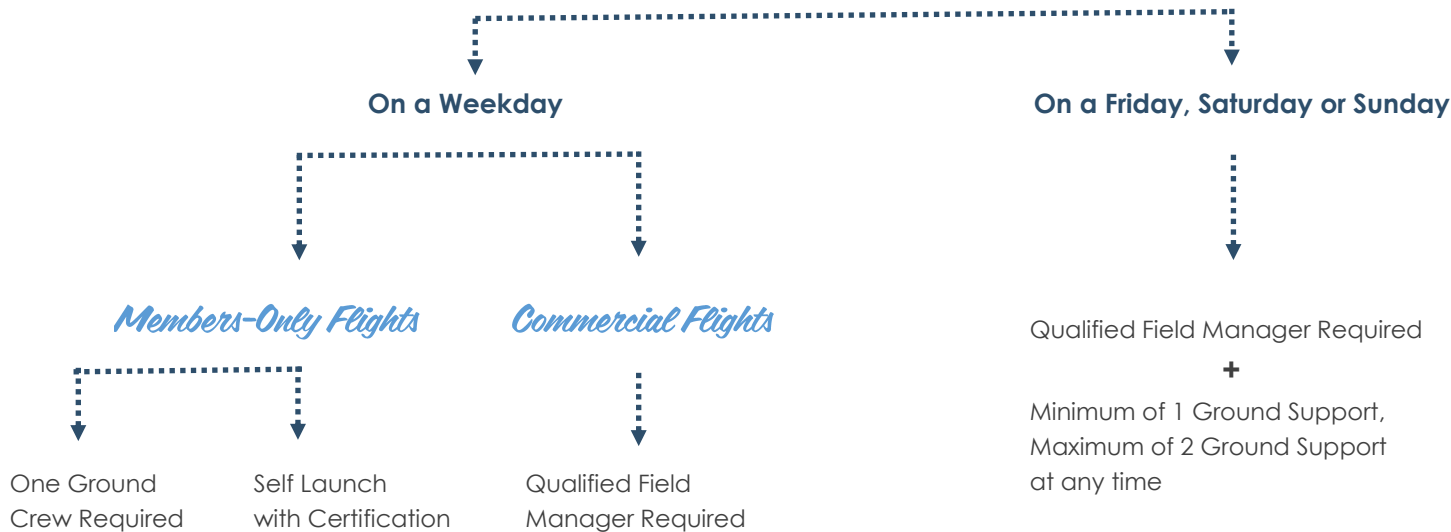

Participants in the Youth Work-Study Program may earn credits for Ground Support and field management hours worked after receiving their HRS Ground Badge. A maximum of two youth members may earn credits for any one shift. The Chief Field Operations Managers will monitor the Team-Up to determine if an Adult Field Manager is required. **Chief Field Managers are Qualified Field Managers appointed by the Board to oversee the calendar and provide Ground Support Check-Outs for the HRS Ground Badge.
